MESSAGE FROM QUINCY BENBOW

Dear Friends and Supporters,

As Chair of the Board of On-Ramps to Careers, I am thrilled to reflect on the incredible strides we made in 2024 and to share our vision for the year ahead. Together, we are creating life-changing opportunities for young people, equipping them with the skills and experiences they need to thrive in technology-driven careers.

This past year, our programs reached new heights. We supported 301 interns—244 high school students from 29 DC schools and 57 college students from 36 colleges and universities. These interns gained invaluable realworld experience, contributing to their future success. Our retention rates—98% for high school interns and 95% for college interns—demonstrate our commitment to creating supportive, impactful opportunities for all participants.

We are particularly proud of several milestones this year. Our outreach efforts expanded significantly, with 761 applications—a 35% increase from 2023. We hosted 10 professional development workshops, helping interns enhance their skills and confidence. Additionally, 35 employers partnered with us to provide transformative work-based learning experiences. We also celebrated new partnerships with the Mayor's Office for MBSYEP, UDC TRIO, and honored Microsoft as Employer of the Year and Learnie as New Employer of the Year.

One of the most exciting additions to our program was the launch of our AI Skills Camp, equipping students with cutting-edge knowledge in artificial intelligence. This innovation reflects our commitment to staying ahead of industry trends and ensuring our interns are prepared for the workforce of tomorrow.

Our success would not be possible without the generosity of our supporters. This year, we secured significant resources to grow our programs, including a \$100,000 Learn24 Grant and contributions from 22 corporate sponsors—nearly doubling last year's number. We are deeply grateful for this trust and investment in our mission.

We also celebrated the achievements of our remarkable interns and alumni at our Signing Day event, featuring keynote speaker Joshua Morgan from the Washington Commanders. These moments remind us of the profound impact our work has on the lives of young people and the communities we serve.

Looking ahead, we are eager to build on this momentum. In 2025, we aim to expand our reach even further, deepen our employer partnerships, and continue innovating our programs to provide unparalleled opportunities for our students.

Your continued support is the driving force behind our success. Whether through hosting interns, providing financial contributions, or volunteering, every effort makes a meaningful difference. Together, we are empowering the next generation of tech leaders and changing lives for the better.


